George Tjungurrayi 'paintings'

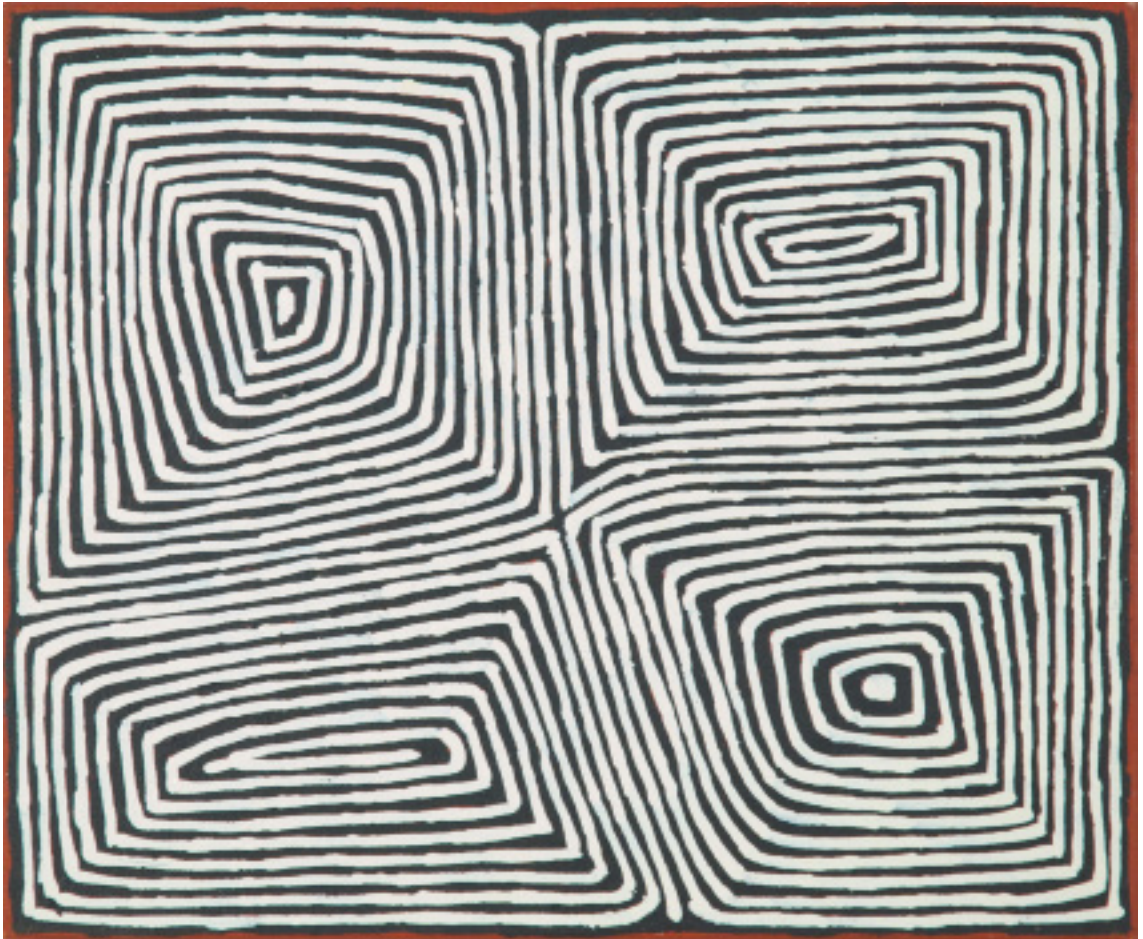

George Tjungurrayi is a senior Papunya Tula artist, a Pintupi man, born in the Western desert where he lives and works today. His country near Wilkinkarra (Lake Mackay) provides the inspiration for all of his work.

George Tjungurrayi is at the forefront of contemporary art in Australia. His work is part of the mainstream vision for Australian art. Over the years he has worked in the traditional dot motif style but has developed a unique linear style which has defined his oeuvre and which has captured the attention of art lovers world wide.

This latest exhibition shows the breadth of the mature style of this septuagenarian. It is vital and exciting work, pulsing with energy, activating the eyes and drawing us into abstract compositions empowered by George's technical virtuosity and the deep meaning from which they are informed.
